



MAPONYA MALL KLIPSPRUIT EXT 5, SOWETO

Dr Richard Maponya is a well-known figure who has contributed to the development of Soweto. He launched Maponya Mall in 2007 as a first-class mall for the people of Soweto. This vibrant 70 000m² mall houses flagship stores for top national retailers as well as local businesses.

Maponya Mall is centrally located and is the happening hub around which the community revolves. The mall services all the needs of shoppers – fashion, food, entertainment, banking, hair and beauty, electronics, eyewear and more. It also offers convenient service centres such as home affairs, labour, transport, a post office, SASSA and many others.

The centre is everything for everyone in the Soweto community, from high-end shoppers to blue collar workers, and is hailed as the Soul of Soweto.

AUDIENCE

Maponya Mall has two clusters of shoppers. The majority of shoppers (80%) are black females between the ages of 30 to 40 years within the LSM 5 to 7 group. They are household decision-makers and are described as 'Neighbourhood Sistas' who have dependants living with them. Of these, 53% visit the mall because it is conveniently located to where they live, for its food facilities and government service centres. The minority cluster (20%) are black females aged between 20 to 30 years and classified as LSM 8 to 7. They are described as the 'Rise Abovers'. They live in but work outside of Soweto, are highly mobile and tend to make scheduled trips to the mall.

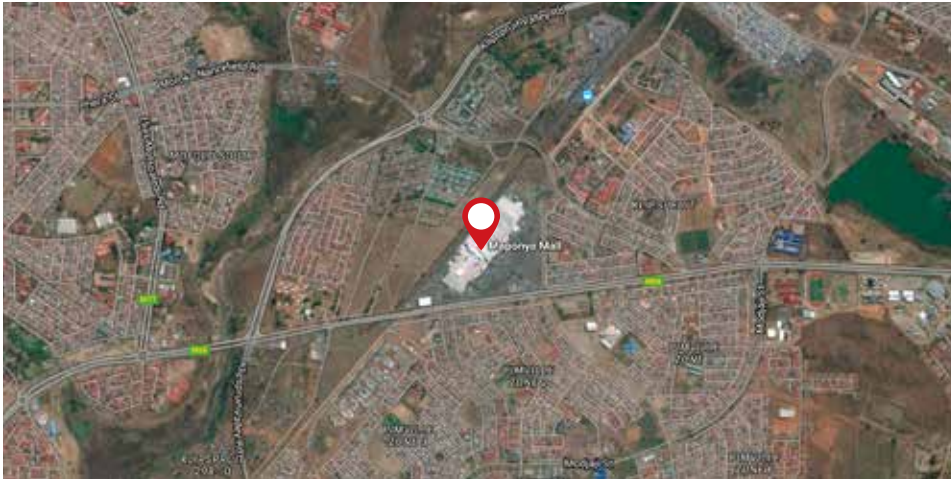
